so much thanks card

Materials list:

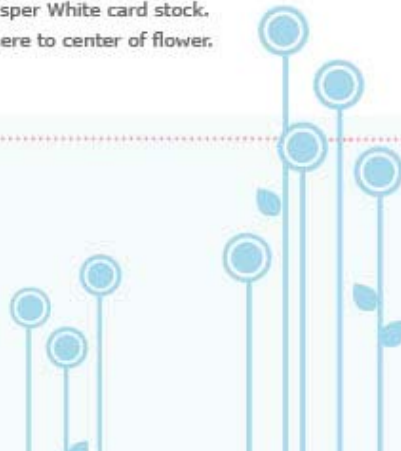
- So Much stamp set
 - Regal Rose card stock
 - Whisper White card stock
 - Tempting Turquoise textured card stock
 - Regal Rose Classic Stampin' Pad®
 - Tempting Turquoise Classic Stampin' Pad
- Whisper White Craft Stampin' Pad®
 - White Stampin' Emboss® Powder
 - Whisper White taffeta ribbon
 - Fresh Favorites I buttons
 - Coluzzle Cutting System
 - Heat tool

Step-by-step:

1. Stamp circle image in Tempting Turquoise ink on Tempting Turquoise textured card stock. Stamp "Thanks" in Whisper White ink in middle of circle. Cover sentiment with White Stampin' Emboss powder, and heat emboss.
2. Color both sides of Whisper White taffeta ribbon with Regal Rose ink, using baby wipe to set color. Dry using heat tool. Tie ribbon around front of card.
3. Stamp line and dot circle images in Tempting Turquoise and Regal Rose ink on Whisper White card stock. Cut out using Coluzzle Cutting System. Adhere to card, and trim card stock to edge of card.
4. Stamp flower image in Regal Rose ink on Regal Rose card stock. Cut out and adhere to card.
5. Thread Tempting Turquoise button with strip of Whisper White card stock. Adhere to center of flower.
